Resolution No. 103/ 2022 MAFSU/89th E.C. Meeting Dated 23/08/2022

Guidelines for the Establishment of Agricultural Technology Information Centre (ATIC) in MAFSU, Nagpur.

A. Preamble

National Agricultural Research System has generated number of agricultural technologies for the benefit of the farmers. But, the farmers are not able to use these technologies due to lack of access to the information. To bridge this gap of information, Agricultural Technology Information Centers (ATIC) have been established in the country.

ATIC is established as a 'single window' delivery system for the technology, services and products of the University for the benefit of the farming community. ATIC provides farm advisory services and facilitate information-based decision making among farmers.

Since, ATIC was not available in the university it was thought to have the ATIC in all the constituent colleges of the University.

Accordingly the Hon'ble Executive Council in the 85th meeting held on 7th April, 2021 has accorded the approval for the establishment of ATIC in the University vide resolution No 10/2021.

B. Objectives of the ATICs

- a. To provide single-window delivery system for the technology and service support to farmers and other stakeholders.
- b. To facilitate direct access of technologies and services to farmers and other stakeholders.
- c. To find out the farmer's problems in field conditions and provide appropriate solution.

Guidelines for Establishment /Functioning of ATIC in the University

1. The Name of the Centre shall be Agricultural Technology Information Centre (ATIC).
2. ATIC will be at all constituent colleges and Maharashtra Animal and Fishery Sciences University, Futala Lake, Nagpur. However at Nagpur and Udgir campus different institutes under MAFSU can jointly develop ATIC centres wherein all institutes will jointly share all the manpower, inputs, facilities and buildings.



3. The Centre may be opened at the Department of Extension Education / Teaching Veterinary Clinical Complex (TVCC). However, the place may be decided by college advisory committee.

4. Components of ATIC

- i. Display unit / Exhibitory Hall (including photo gallery)
- ii. Training cum Conference room with projection unit
- iii. Advisory unit
- iv. Sale Counter
- v. Services

i) Display unit / Exhibitory Hall (Including photo gallery)

- a. All Veterinary and Animal Sciences Colleges will display available boards with relevant information viz. species, local breeds of livestock and poultry, fodder varieties, feeding, housing, disease management etc.
- b. All Dairy Technology Colleges will display boards with relevant information on different milk products, testing, procurement, processing, etc.
- c. All Fishery Colleges will display boards with relevant information of different species, varieties of fishes, feeding, disease, pond management, value addition, etc.
- d. ATIC at University headquarter, will display all species and breeds of livestock, poultry, and fishes, fodder varieties, university milestone, etc.

ii) Training cum Conference room with projection unit

All ATIC will have well-furnished and equipped training cum conference room with projection unit for direct interaction with the farmers/stakeholders.

iii) Advisory unit

There will be an advisory unit for giving advice to farmers, entrepreneurs etc. The advisory cell will be functional once in a week for first few weeks and if response is considerable then it will be made available on demand basis. It may be composed of two to three experts. Advisory cell may advice the clients on demand basis during office working hours through telephone and email replies.



iv) Sale counter

- a. Established centers will sell their own or other college products under MAFSU.
- b. The Veterinary colleges will sell books, other farm literature, techno-economic feasible entrepreneurial project reports, fodder stumps, seeds, etc.
- c. Dairy Technology colleges may sell books farm literature, entrepreneurial project reports, milk products etc.
- d. Fishery Science colleges may sell books and other farm literature, entrepreneurial project reports, aquarium, seeds, ornamental fishes etc.

v) Services

- a. Veterinary and Animal Science Colleges will provide paid services like blood analysis, urine analysis, fecal sample analysis, Milk testing, antibiotic sensitivity test, post-mortem, diagnostic services etc. and trainings for farmers, master trainers, technicians etc.
- b. The Dairy Technology colleges will provide paid consultancy services, milk testing, trainings on value additions, etc.
- c. The Fishery Science colleges will promote trainings, consultancy services, disease diagnostic services, soil testing, water testing, etc.

- 5) Development of Audio Visual Aids and Extension literature** The extension literature in print format like pamphlet, leaflet manuals, booklets, books and electronic format like CDs/DVDs Videos will be prepared / developed and at college / University level and will be made available in digital and print form for distribution and sale.
- 6). Information about services/product available / digital literature / videos be displayed at ATIC Centre & also uploaded on college and university website
 - 7). All ATIC should have chambers for I/C ATIC supported with the manpower, mobile, phone, computer, etc. As per EC resolution 10/21 date 07/04/21 one techno savvy contractual labour shall be appointed to assist coordinator ATIC Cell.
 - 8) All ATICs should maintain data like feedback from end users towards technology transfer, product sold and services provided by centres to the Institutes' scientists.
 - 9) All ATICs should maintain various registers like visitors books, farmers query books, salebooks, etc.
