Col. Prof. (Dr.) A . M. Paturkar, Hon'ble Vice Chancellor & Chairman, ECEC also welcomed the members of the Extension & Continuing Education Council (ECEC) attending the 13th meeting of ECEC. Hon'ble Chairman briefed the house on the activities of University during previous year. He informed the house that Academic Officers and Staff of University took

painstaking efforts to do the best possible work but still due to COVID – 19 pandemic some work is pending.

Mansinhka informed the house that Maharashtra State is leader in Go-seva and conservation of 'Deshi Gowansh' He opined to undertake activities/projects on improvement of 'Deshi Gowansh' and organic farming in adopted villages under the Unnat Bharat Abhiyan. Hon'ble Member Dr. Randhir Singh observed that the many colleges/institute have mentioned 'noted' or left blank in the ATR. He informed that the ATR should be clear.

Dr. Aher, DEE & Member Secretary informed the house that there will be presentation by DEE, MAFSU followed by the Associate Deans of the constituent colleges/institute of MAFSU and Programme Coordinator / Senior Scientist cum In-charge Officer of KVK's of MAFSU.

Dr. Aher, DEE presented the overview of extension activities and publications done by the University. Dr. Aher presented summary of regular extension activities organized during the Calendar Year 2020 (January – December 2020) by the constituent colleges/institute of MAFSU, details of webinars organized by MAFSU through Facebook Live, progress/status/activities of KVK's under MAFSU (Dudhbardi, Nagpur / Tadsar Sangli / Nagaon, Thane), activities undertaken in adopted villages under Unnat Bharat Abhiyan during Calendar Year 2020, report of activities during COVID – 19 submitted to Hon'ble Chancellor Office, Maharashtra, software/application developed by MAFSU for Extension Activity Data Collection, advisories issued by MAFSU for awareness towards Bird Flu through Doordarshan & Akashwani, MAFSU – Best Teacher Award (Extension) Award 2020 and regular publications of MAFSU (MAFSU Varta, MAFSU Annual Report 2019 – 20, Calendar 2021 & leaflets).

Dr. Aher, DEE requested the Associate Deans of the constituent colleges/institute of MAFSU and Programme Coordinator / Senior Scientist cum In-charge Officer of KVK's of MAFSU to present the report of extension activities carried out during the Calendar Year 2020 (January – December 2020).

The Associate Deans of the constituent colleges/institute of MAFSU presented the respective regular extension activities organized during the Calendar Year 2020 (January – December 2020) on following points:

The Programme Coordinator / Senior Scientist cum In-charge Officer of KVK's of MAFSU presented the extension activities carried out by KVK's during the Calendar Year 2020 and training proposed for the Year 2021.

Hon'ble Vice Chancellor & Chairman, ECEC requested Hon'ble Members to offer their suggestions/remarks on the activities carried out by the constituent colleges/institute and KVK's.

Hon'ble Member Dr. Arya appreciated the presentation of the university and colleges/KVK's. He suggested to make an attempt to make distinction between up-skilling activities and re-skilling activities of various skill up gradation trainings conducted by the University. The content of such trainings should also be distinct. Dr. Arya further informed that ASCI is making a platform by the name Learning Resource Platform (LRF) for knowledge sharing and University should collaborate with ASCI for contribution for LRF. He also suggested to prepare and share posters about activities of University and posters related to awareness of COVID 19 pandemic.

Hon'ble Member Dr. Rajorhia informed that Indian Dairy Association (IDA) is happy with MAFSU. MAFSU is doing good job in spite of COVID 19 pandemic. He further informed that IDA is receiving many queries from farmers of Maharashtra State regarding the issue of reducing the cost of production of milk. He opined to conduct the study on reduction in cost of production of milk in the adopted villages of University by involving the farmers having 5-10 milk animals. He also stressed to conduct study on environment protection. He suggested to promote the sorted semen technology, to establish model of modern dairy farm at college/KVK farms. He informed the

difficulty faced by farmers during the export of milk & milk products due to issue of FMD free/Mastitis Free certification.

Hon'ble Member Dr. Randhir Singh informed that all the presentations of University and colleges/KVK's were good. He further informed that a virtual mela of farmers was organized in Bengaluru and such type of mela should be organized by MAFSU too. He expressed displeasure that the Success Stories / Yashogatha of MAFSU are not printed and opined that the Success Stories / Yashogatha of MAFSU should be printed in time to keep the relevance of that story. He further opined to work in the direction of providing good quality semen by the University or State Animal Husbandry Department and quality fish fingerlings at villages. He suggested to provide training for preparation of balanced feed formulation and the formulation be provided in area/district specific way. He added that College of Fishery Sciences under MAFSU are having good involvement in Pradhan Mantri Matsya Sampada Yojna (PMMSY). He also suggested to take feedback of farmers/trainees after the completion of training organized by university.

Hon'ble Member Dr. Sharma informed the house that National Dairy Development Board (NDDB) has prepared a software for formulation of balanced ration by using locally available ingredients and the local persons are trained for this ration balancing software. He further informed that the NDDB is also working on manure management. He suggested that all the colleges/KVKs should include training module on fodder management as 70% of expenditure is happening on feeding cost in dairy industry. He inquired about the farmers/trainees adopted the practices of silage preparation and urea treatment. He further suggested for commercialization of fodder development training as Entrepreneurial Training and cited the example of farmers of Aroli Village of Nagpur who are cultivating fodder, chaffing and marketing it.

Hon'ble Member Dr. Dinesh Bhosale congratulated all the colleges of university. He informed the house that all the webinars organized by university were excellent. He appreciated the work done by Veterinary Colleges/Institute of University for the proactive role during the Bird Flu. He suggested to organize maximum webinars/facebook live programmes by University.

Hon'ble Member Dr. Dinesh Bhonde informed the house that YCMOU, Nashik is having reach upto seven lakh students. He opined that MAFSU should take advantage of reach of YCMOU. He suggested that MAFSU, Nagpur & YCMOU, Nashik should collaborate and formulate short courses.

Hon'ble Member Shri. Thakare informed that MAFSU is doing very good extension work. He further informed that cattle population is increasing but the milk production is decreasing. He

opined that genetic development/up gradation of cattle/buffalo breed is necessary, the help of NDDB should be taken, region oriented work in dairy industry is must, Animal Husbandry is the best side business for farmers and impact assessment of extension work should be done.

Hon'ble Member Dr. Mankar informed the house that KVK's of Dr. Panjabrao Deshmukh Krishi Vidyapeeth, Akola can collaborate with KVK's of MAFSU, Nagpur for making data bank. He further informed that KVK's under Dr. PDKV, Akola has ample amount of land, the land can be utilized efficiently, if MAFSU can provide advance model of Animal Husbandry practices for demonstration of beneficiaries. The KVK's under both the Universities can collaborate by exchange of package of practices.
