Col. Prof. (Dr.) A. M. Paturkar, Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor & Chairman, ECEC also welcomed the members of the Extension & Continuing Education Council (ECEC) attending the 14th meeting of ECEC. Hon'ble Chairman briefed the house on the activities of University during previous year. Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor & Chairman gave a special welcome to only woman member in the house, Hon'ble Member Smt. K. U. Mahalle by offering a book on life of Krantijyoti Savitribai Phule as the occasion of the meeting happened to be on World Women's Day.

The house also congratulated Hon'ble Member Shri. R. R. Korde for getting awards for implementing various innovative activities through his venture.

The regular agenda of the meeting was taken up for discussion thereafter with the permission of Hon'ble Chairman.

Subject No. 1/2022 Confirmation of minutes of 13th Meeting of Hon'ble Extension & Continuing Education Council held on 26th February 2021.

Dr. Bhikane, DEE & Member Secretary informed the house that the minutes of 13th meeting of Hon'ble Extension & Continuing Education Council held on February 26th, 2021 were circulated to all the members and no suggestions and remarks were received to the university from any member. He further requested the members to present their observations, if any with regards to the minutes of last meeting. Dr. Bhikane, DEE & Member Secretary placed the action taken report of the decisions of 13th Meeting of Hon'ble Extension & Continuing Education Council held on February 26th, 2021 before the house.

After going through the action taken report following resolution was passed.

Subject No. 3/2022 Regarding the review of Extension Activities conducted by the constituent colleges / institute during the calendar year 2021.

Dr. Bhikane, DEE & Member Secretary informed the house that there will be presentation by DEE, MAFSU followed by the Associate Deans of the constituent colleges/institute of MAFSU, Director, WRTC and Senior Scientist cum Heads KVK's of MAFSU.

Dr. Bhikane, DEE presented the overview of extension activities and publications done by the University. Dr. Bhikane presented summary of regular extension activities organized during the Calendar Year 2021 (January – December 2021) by the constituent colleges/institute of MAFSU, advisories issued by MAFSU through M-Kisan portal, launching of mafsu.in domain email ids for the staff of the University, trainings under MAITRI sponsored by MLDB, Micro Training Centres (MTC) sponsored by NDDB, infertility management trainings, camps & awareness campaigns under Vidarbha Marathwada Dairy Development Project (VMDDP), constitution & activities of Extension Activity Cell of MAFSU, progress/status/activities of KVK's under MAFSU (Dudhbardi, Nagpur / Tadsar Sangli / Nagaon, Thane), activities undertaken in adopted villages under Unnat Bharat Abhiyan during Calendar Year 2021, activities of ATIC Centre, visibility of MAFSU through the constituted Media Cell, constitution of committee for breed conservation, participation in various exhibitions, celebrations of various days, report of work done during FMD & LSD outbreaks in the state and regular publications of MAFSU (MAFSUVARTA, MAFSU Annual Report 2020 – 21 & MAFSU Calendar 2022).

Thereafter, Dr. Bhikane, DEE requested the Associate Deans of the constituent colleges/institute of MAFSU, Director, WRTC and Senior Scientist cum Head of KVK's of MAFSU to present the report of extension activities carried out during the Calendar Year 2021 (January – December 2021).

The Associate Deans of the constituent colleges/institute of MAFSU presented the regular extension activities organized during the Calendar Year 2021 (January – December 2021) on following points:

The Director, WRTC and Senior Scientist cum Heads of KVK's of MAFSU presented the extension activities carried out by them during the Calendar Year 2021 and proposed trainings for the Year 2022.

Hon'ble Vice Chancellor & Chairman, ECEC requested Hon'ble Members to offer their suggestions/remarks on the activities carried out by the constituent colleges/institute, WRTC and KVK's.

Hon'ble Member Shri. Mansinhka told that 'Govansh Swawlamban Deta Hain' and suggested to organize training programmes about Go-vigyan activities by the University. Dr. Bhikane, DEE informed that the training on Go-vigyan activities are included in the modules of dairy trainings conducted by the constituent colleges of university.

Hon'ble Member Dr. Kamble praised the extension work of MAFSU carried out through its various establishments. He expressed that Punyashlok Ahilyadevi Sheep and Goat Development Board, Pune is keen to work in collaboration with MAFSU, Nagpur. He suggested deputing the internship students of MAFSU to the farm of Punyashlok Ahilyadevi Sheep and Goat Development Board, Pune for at least 10 – 15 days during the scheduled ITP program. He informed that, since the Berari Goat is recognized by NBAGR, Punyashlok Ahilyadevi Sheep and Goat Development Board, Pune is taking efforts to popularize the Berari Goat by developing nucleus herd of Berari Goats and practising Artificial Insemination for the development of local herds in the Vidarbha

region. He also informed that the board is concentrating on the development of local breeds, generation of database of sheep & goat owners in the state.

Hon'ble Member Dr. Upadhye informed the house that the breeding policy of State Govt. restricts the Artificial Insemination in Sheep & Goat and policy needs reconsideration.

Hon'ble Member Shri. Singh, Commissioner (Animal Husbandry) informed the house that 380 interns of MAFSU joined various State Govt. centres. He emphasized that the students from MAFSU should start extension activities from their own villages as students can be major instrument for extension activities. He further opined that MAFSU's extension wing and Department of Animal Husbandry should develop KVK's as focal point for dissemination of technologies for farmers in the state.

Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor & Chairman suggested to explore the possibilities of collaboration of MAFSU, Department of Animal Husbandry & NDDB for improvement of farms of constituent colleges of MAFSU.

Hon'ble member Shri. Dhote narrated the story of MAFSU since inception and informed that the University faced tough times during the course. He expressed his proud feelings about the marching of the University in right direction with progress for the development of the farming community. He suggested to include trainings on organic farming by the MAFSU KVK's. He also opined that the Hon'ble Members of the Extension & Continuing Education Council of MAFSU be invited to various programmes organized by the constituent colleges.

Hon'ble member Dr. Gade praised the Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor & Chairman as a very dynamic personality. He appreciated all the extension related activities & programmes of MAFSU. He informed that even though Dr. PDKV, Akola is bifurcated, Dr. PDKV, Akola and MAFSU, Nagpur should work in collaboration in various activities viz., increasing the women participation as entrepreneur through the SHG, training on preparation of innovative milk products etc. He congratulated MAFSU, Nagpur for the establishment of KVK's.

Hon'ble Member Dr. Sharma congratulated MAFSU, Nagpur for the establishment of KVK's. He suggested to conduct the various demonstration at farmer's doorstep and to promote chaff cutting practices in adopted villages as well as to organize large demonstrations at University level. He further suggested to organize trainings on calf rearing and pellet feed production.

Hon'ble Member Smt. Mahalle appreciated the work of MAFSU on Woman empowerment through the involvement of women in various extension activities. She offered support for the organization of various trainings for the improvement of household income for the women through dairying and other livestock based activities. She suggested promoting trainings on sericulture through the new KVK's under MAFSU.

Hon'ble Member Dr. Rajorhia appreciated the work of MAFSU in spite of COVID 19 pandemic situation. He informed the house that he gets regular feedback about the quality of extension literature in the form of various publications of MAFSU.

Hon'ble Member Dr. Randhir Singh informed that all the presentations of University and colleges/KVK's were good. He emphasized to provide training on packaging practices,

demonstrations etc. as well as to manage FPO's for the sustainable development of the farming community.

Hon'ble Member Dr. Dudhbade suggested to organize trainings on hygienic chicken selling, value addition of chicken etc.

Hon'ble Member Shri. Korde suggested to sensitizing the farmers on organic feeding to animals to reduce the feeding cost as well as to focus on different streams of income for sustainability in dairy venture.

Hon'ble Member Dr. Gadakh, DEE, MPKV, Rahuri appreciated the extension work of the University and congratulated all the Associate Deans for nice presentation.

The house after thorough discussion passed the following resolution.
